

Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency
2017 Notice of Funding Availability (Pre-Application)
Community Development Block Grant

The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) is soliciting pre-applications for eligible public facility installation, rehabilitation and improvement projects under the FY 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. SHRA is the Grantee of CDBG funds received annually from HUD and administers the funds on behalf of the City and County of Sacramento. The Sacramento City Council and the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors have approved the allocation of \$100,000 (in each jurisdiction) in CDBG funds for eligible public facility projects within their respective jurisdictions. Requests must be valued greater than \$5,000, but no more than \$100,000. Projects will be reviewed and ranked on impact, timeline and project eligibility per CDBG regulations. Top ranked projects will be invited to submit a full application.

Eligible applicants include: non-profit organizations (including faith-based organizations), units of local government; other governmental entities or public agencies; County of Sacramento, and the Cities of Sacramento, Folsom, Isleton and Galt (the cities of Elk Grove, Citrus Heights and Rancho Cordova receive their own CDBG entitlement and are ineligible to apply, as is any public facility or nonprofit with a service area determined to be a majority served within those jurisdiction boundaries.).

Examples of eligible public facilities include neighborhood parks or playgrounds, community/senior/youth centers, recreational facilities, homeless facilities, etc. Activities must create or extend the useful life of the public facility. Examples of eligible activities include replacement and/or construction and installation of HVAC, energy efficient windows, new pathways, improvements to remove accessibility barriers, restroom improvements, picnic tables, benches, new play equipment, activation of neighborhood sports fields and courts and lighting.
