## (Frequently Asked Questions)

### **October 8, 2013 HCV FAQ:**

**Question: Will HAP checks to landlords be delayed due to the Federal budget not passing?**

**Answer:** The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) is continually monitoring the status of the federal budget and a potential government shutdown. The Agency is responding accordingly to the impact on federal HUD programs that SHRA administers on behalf of the City and County of Sacramento.

Here is some information on the Agency's response to the federal budget situation.

- All Housing Authority offices are open and housing operations (Housing Choice Voucher and Conventional Public Housing Programs) will continue.
- Housing Assistance Payments (HAP) have been mailed to landlords. If you have not received your check by the 10th of the month, please contact Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) staff.
- Tenants should continue to comply with the terms of their lease agreements and are responsible for paying rent on time.
- Appointments for HCV and CNV participants and applicants will take place as scheduled.
- Funding assistance for homeless programs and HOPWA programs will continue.
- Until further notice, vendors will be paid according to their contracts with the Agency.

SHRA will provide updates on the website as needed when information becomes available.
