CDBG-R specifically recommends grantees identify activities previously approved to receive funding from its regular 2009 CDBG allocation and consider whether activities could be accelerated by being funded with CDBG-R. The Auburn Boulevard project meets this requirement. In the third quarter of 2011, the Auburn Boulevard Streetscape Project (between Bell Street and Fulton Avenue) went out to bid and construction has begun. Homeless prevention activities meet the intent of the CDBG-R funds by utilizing the public service component to assist those most impacted by the recession. CDBG-R public service funds provide an additional opportunity for longer lasting system improvements, shifting from a system organized around shelter to one centered on prevention and housing stability. HUD encourages a coordinated process with central intake and communitiy wide tools to assess the individual's risk of homelessness and housing needs. \$100,000 was spent in the 1st quarter of 2011 for the above activity. An additional \$35,000 was committed to the homeless prevention activites	

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in the 2nd quarter of 2011.
