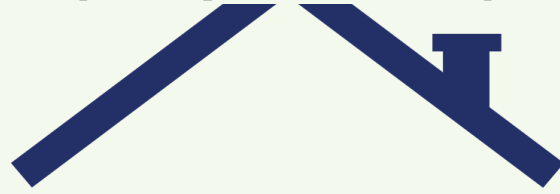

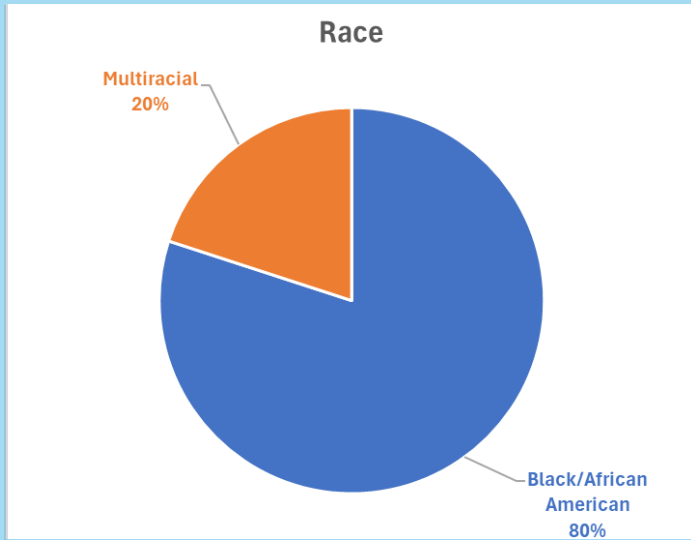

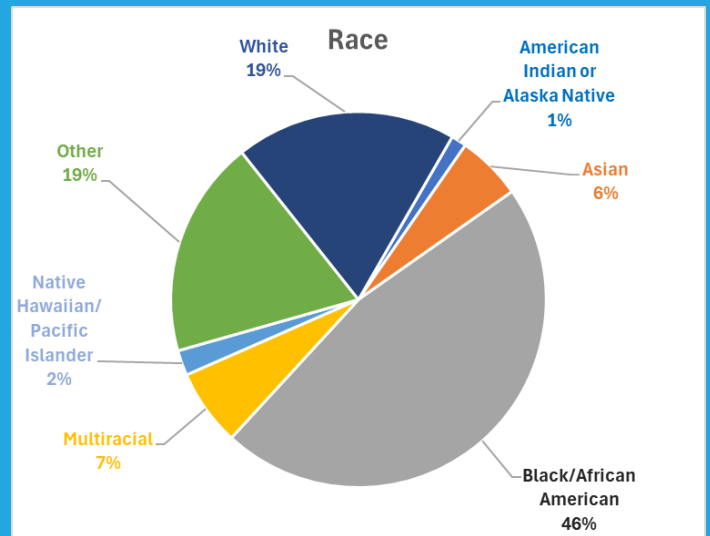
Head of Household Demographics for Households Receiving Disbursements

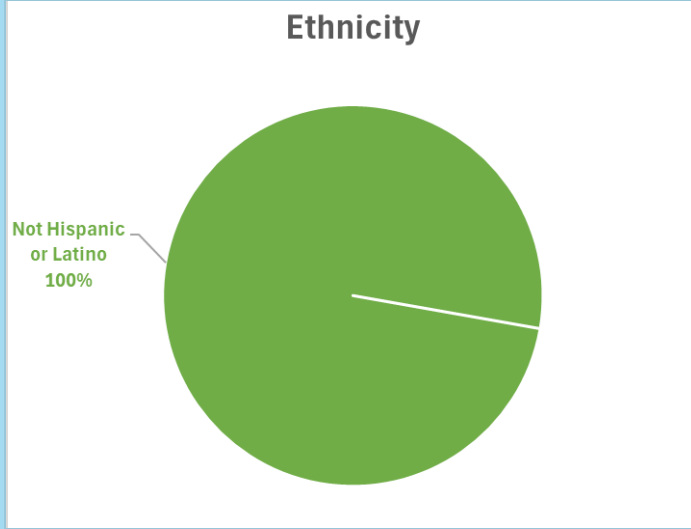

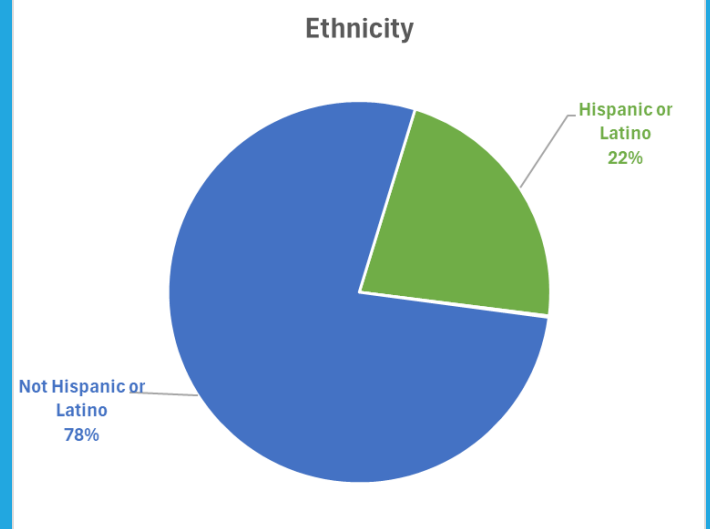

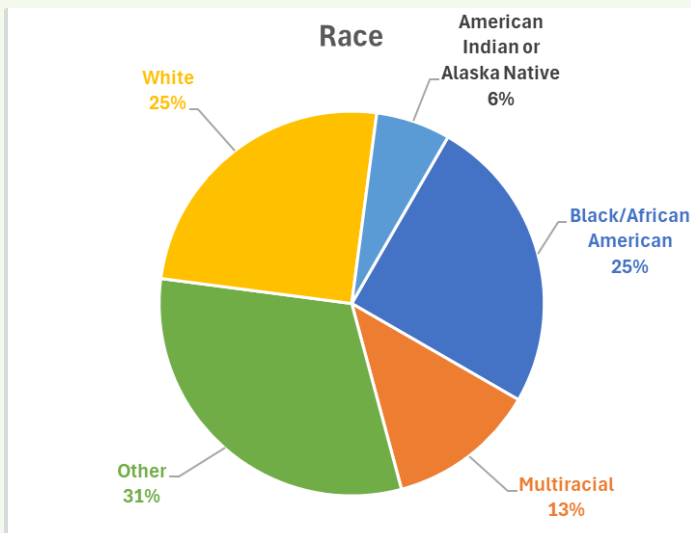

City Program to Date

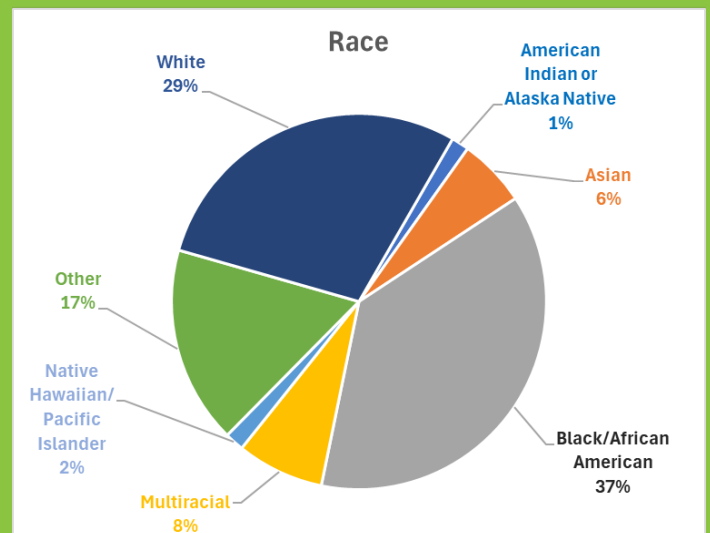


County May



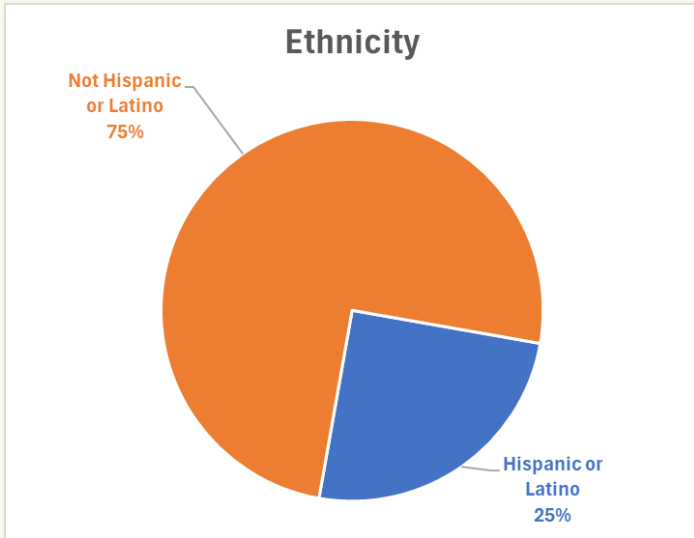

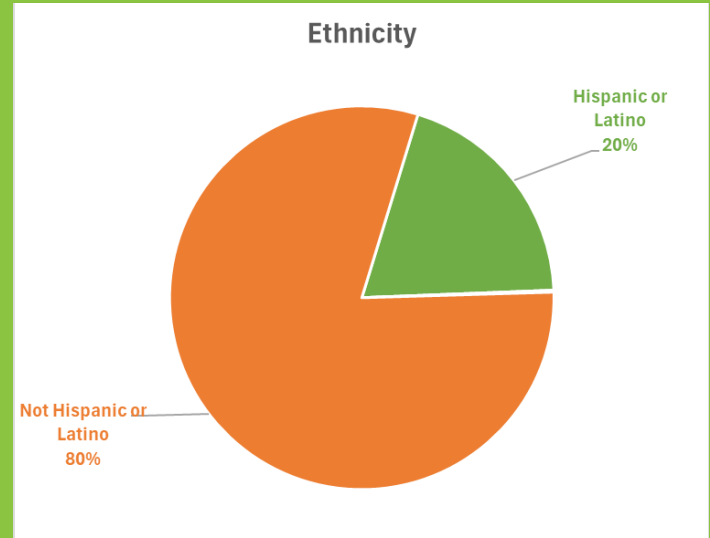

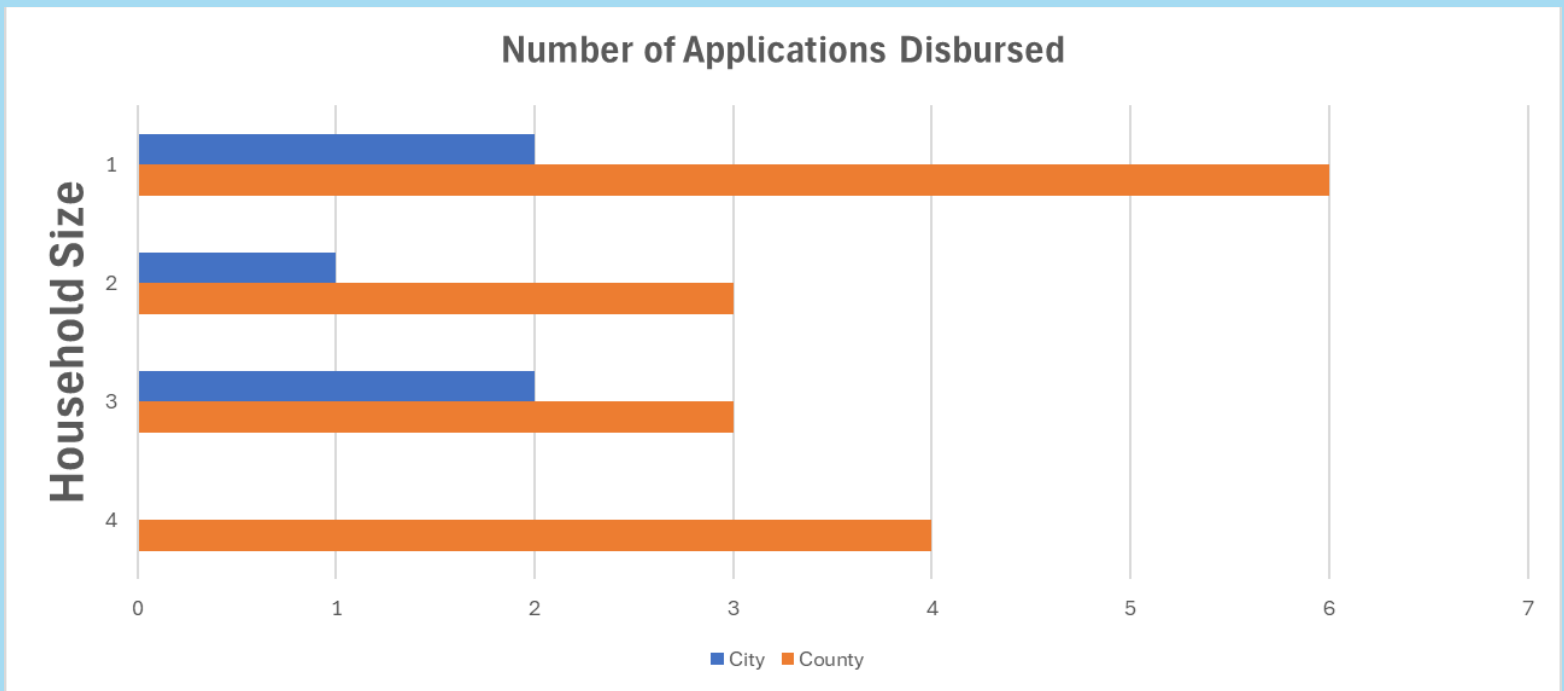


County Program to Date



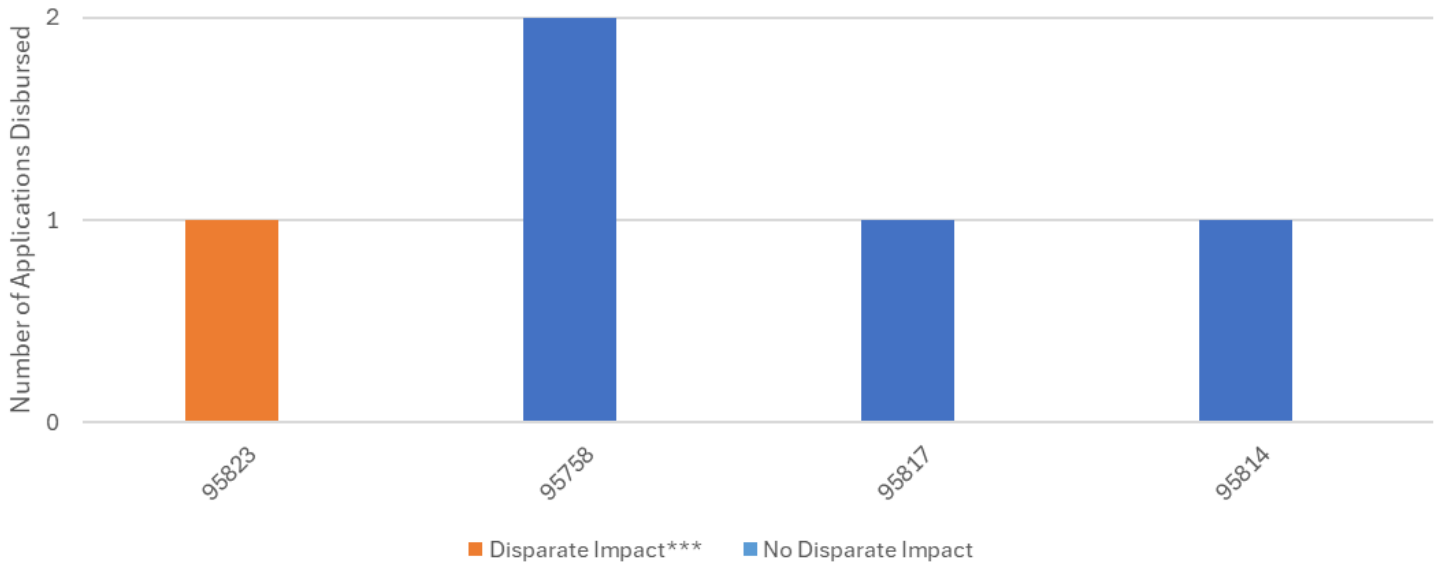
May Disbursements By Household Size

City/County

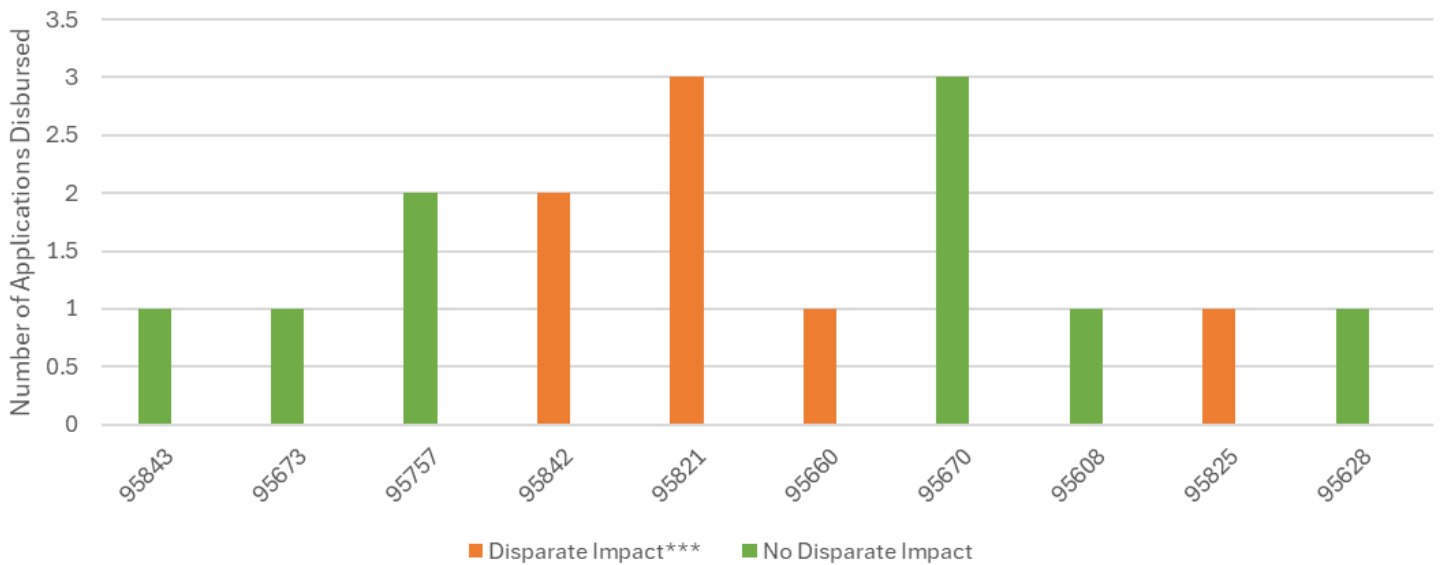


May Top Disbursement Zip Codes
