SHRA's ESG providers utilizes SHRA's ESG Desk Manuals to administer the program per 24 CFR Parts 91 and 576. SHRA will contract with providers to utilize ESG funds to operate and provide essential services to a homeless shelter, rapid re-housing and prevention. ESG funds will only be used for eligible activities as described in the ESG regulations. SHRA requires that its subrecipients / providers enter client demographic data into HMIS in a timely fashion per SSF's HMIS policies. HMIS client data is utilized to complete the ESG CAPER in SAGE. The 2024 ESG federal entitlement funding allocation is approximately \$512,999. For a detailed breakdown of the ESG funds refer to AP-38. Actual amounts depend upon final grant award as determined by HUD. In addition, administering the City and County of Sacramento's federal ESG entitlement on behalf of the two jurisdictions, SHRA is also the Continuum of Care's Administrative Entity for the State of

California's Housing and Community Development (HCD) ESG funds (entitlement). The 2021 and 2022 State ESG funds are to be fully expended by December 31, 2023. Anticipated start date for 2023 State ESG is January 1, 2024. Funding will be utilized for an emergency shelter and the rapid re-housing program. SHRA has submitted the 2022 ESG State and ESG-CV grant application. SHRA will submit the 2023 grant application upon state issuance.
